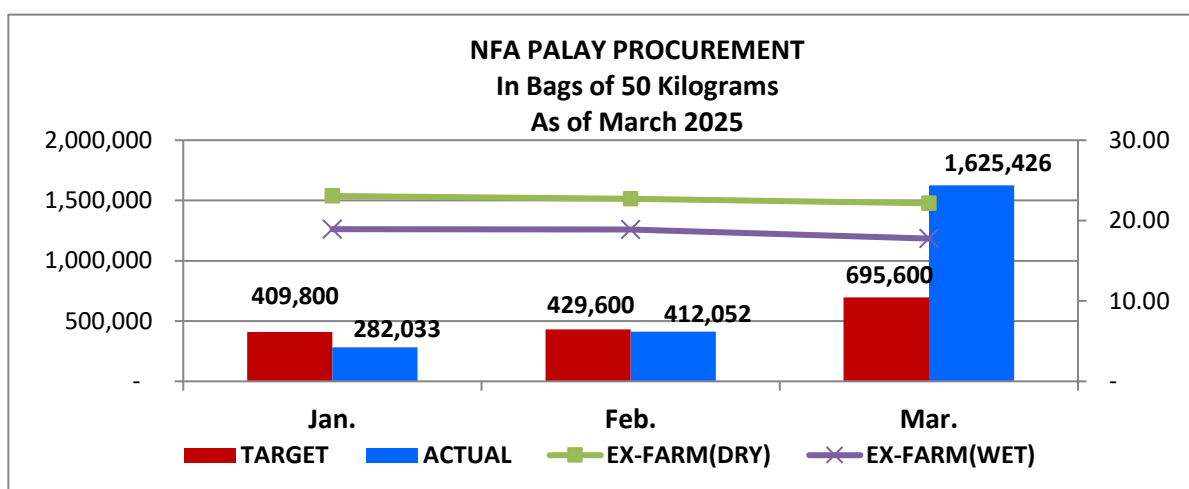


## I. OPERATIONS COORDINATION DEPARTMENT

### A. Ensure Food Security through Maintenance of Adequate Buffer Stock Sourced from Local Farmers

#### 1. Palay Procurement

For the month of March the National Food Authority (NFA) procured 1,625,426 bags (81,271.3 MT) of palay, reaching 233.67% of its target of 695,600 bags (34,780 MT). Increase in procurement compared to last month is mainly due to favorable harvest this cropping season, and the continuous implementation of the Council-approved Price Range Scheme (PRICERS) for palay procurement activity.

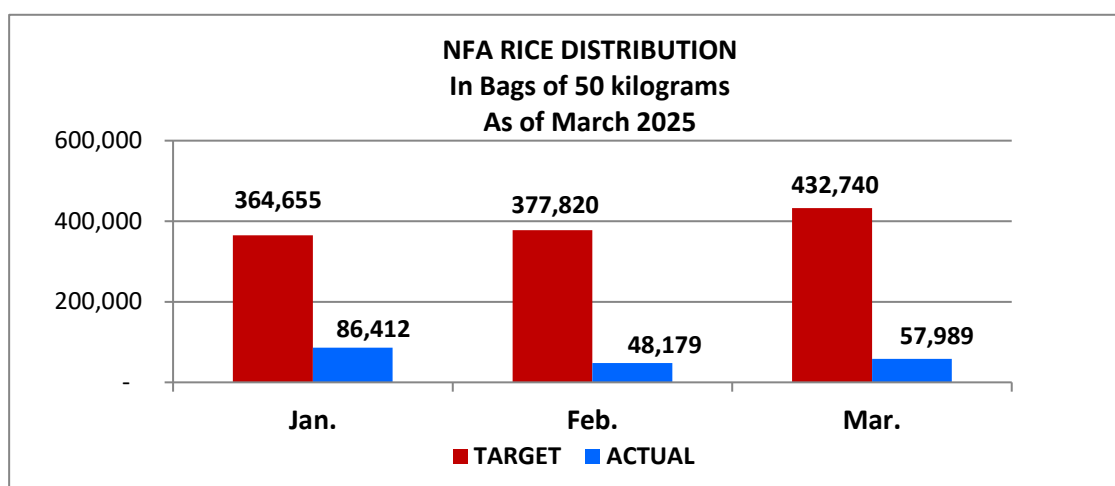

#### 2. Distribution

For the month of March, NFA distributed 57,989 bags (2,899.45 MT) of milled rice, achieving only 13.40% of the target of 432,740 bags (21,637 MT), despite the declaration of Food Security Emergency (FSE). Issuances were made to the following:

- 38, 888.94 bags to DSWD, OCD, Legislators, and LGU's for relief operations / calamity response
- 4,173.97 bags for government agencies and LGU's rice requirement under EO-51 program
- 7,125.50 bags for the grant of One-Time Rice Allowance
- 7,800 bags for LGU's under the Food Security Emergency Program



### 3. NFA Inventory

As of March 31, 2025, NFA has a Total Expected Milled Rice Inventory (TEMRI) stock inventory of 6,861,752 bags (343,088 MT). It should be noted that NFA's inventory is 19% of the country's national rice inventory.
